

New Generation Initiative Scholarships

Help keep our community vibrant by bringing in the next generation! Being a sponsor is a great way to share the music and dance we all love.

Seven NGI scholarships will be distributed among the several CDS Boston sessions. Sponsors and applicants are especially encouraged to consider applying to English-Scottish and Labor Day weekend sessions.

The CDS Boston draft guideline allows for some flexibility in distributing the seven scholarships, but they are tentatively assigned as follows:

- First Weekend: zero to two campers
- 4th of July Weekend: zero to two campers
- ESS: one to two campers
- Labor Day: two to four campers

Scholarships are available to people who are teens old enough to be admitted as an adult to a camp session, and to young adults through the age of 30 years. Preference will be given to those who are new to Pinewoods camp, have financial need, have enthusiasm or talent for dance, and a desire to participate fully.

The sponsor actively seeks a suitable candidate and assists with registration and other preparation for camp. Consider being a sponsor, or suggesting a likely scholarship recipient for sponsoring if you are not able to be the sponsor yourself.
