

Directions to CDS-Boston Centre's 2008 Summer Series

First Unitarian Society of Newton, 1326 Washington Street, West Newton

corner of Washington Street & Highland Street, across from the police station

The Unitarian church has a square stone tower & is on the north side of the Mass Pike

NOTE: Second Church in Newton has a tall stone spire which can serve as a landmark for West Newton Square. The square-towered Unitarian church is across the Pike from Second Church, on Highland Street.

Parking:

Street parking is available on the surrounding streets. There are also some parking lots ("P" on map) we can use: bank lot across Highland Street; municipal lot between Cherry & Elm behind the stores; commuter rail lot across the street from Blue Ribbon Bar-B-Q. Do **NOT** park on the bridge over the Mass Pike or in the Second Church lot.

From I-95/Route 128:

From the south: exit 21; from the north: exit 21A, after the service plaza - Rte 16/West Newton/Wellesley exit. Turn right at the end of exit ramp onto Washington Street (Rte 16). Continue approx 2 miles into West Newton Square.

**The Unitarian church will be on your right after Tody's Service Station; turn right at the Highland St light.

(if you wish to park in the municipal lot, go straight across the intersection at Tody's onto Elm. To park in the commuter rail lot, loop left at that intersection onto Washington & turn left into the commuter rail lot.)

From Mass Pike eastbound (Natick, Framingham):

Take I-95/Route 128 South exit. Proceed to exit 21A & follow directions above.

From Mass Pike westbound (Boston, Cambridge):

Take Pike westbound exit 16 – West Newton. Follow signs to West Newton/16 east into West Newton Square (see directions after ** above).

Public Transportation

The best way to get **TO** the dance via public transportation from Boston or Cambridge is to take **commuter rail** from South Station or Back Bay on the Framingham/Worcester line. The West Newton commuter rail stop is a block from the Unitarian church. Do **NOT** take an express train to Natick/Framingham.

Alternatively, the Woodland stop of the Riverside "D" Green Line is a mile and a half from West Newton Square. Turn right on Washington Street and walk to the church.

Commuter rail is **NOT** available at the end of the dance. We will have a Ride Board to facilitate rides to the Red Line and Green Line at the end of the dance.
