

Public Transport Directions to Pinewoods Camp

There is public transportation from Boston and Logan Airport to Plymouth via bus – **Plymouth & Brockton Street Railroad Co. (508-746-0378 www.p-b.com)** and train (Plymouth or Kingston) – **MBTA (800-392-6100 or www.mbta.com)**. The closest bus stations are Plymouth (see above) and Bourne – **Peter Pan/Bonanza (800-3436-9999 www.peterpanbus.com)**. From bus and train stations, there are a number of cab and van services, many of which will also do group runs to and from the airport. Reserve in advance. Airport van service is an ever changing business, we may have new information closer to camp.

Please let us know your flight/bus number and time and if you have booked a van or cab; we may be able to get additional riders for a van, lowering the cost for each.

Have these driving directions handy for taxi and van drivers.

Suggested arrival time at Logan is noon to 3pm, at Plymouth or Buzzards Bay is 3-5pm, at camp is 3-6pm.

Driving Directions to Pinewoods Camp

NOTE: the last part of the highway routes are the same ones that lead to Cape Cod; weekend traffic is heavy. Leave extra time. If you arrive between 3:00 and 6:30 on the arrival afternoon, you will be met at the entrance by a greeting crew. If you arrive later, look for the posted directions at the camp entrance. Dinner is 6:30-7:15.

FROM NEW YORK and SOUTH (5-6 hours):

We recommend avoiding I-95 completely! Take **I-84** or the **Parkways** and **I-91** to Hartford and continue on **I-84** to the **Mass Pike**. (Some people even take surface routes from Hartford to Providence, then Rt 44.)

FROM WEST OF BOSTON:

Take **Mass Pike** to **I-495**. Go **South** on **I-495** to **Rt 44**. Go **East** on **Rt 44** to **Rt 3** and see From Boston to the right.

FROM BOSTON (1-1½ Hours):

Take **Rt 3 South** to **Exit 3: Clark Road, Long Pond**.

Turn **Right** at end of ramp onto **Clark Road**; continue 0.2 miles to stop sign.

Turn **Left** onto **Long Pond Road**; go 1.7 miles to **Halfway Pond Road**.

Turn **Right** onto **Halfway Pond Road**, go 0.8 miles (past white church on left).

Take next **Right** onto **West Long Pond Road** (a wide dirt road); go 0.5 miles to **Cornish Field Road** (a narrow dirt road) on the right. Look for a group of mail boxes on the left and a small **Pinewoods** sign on a tree on the right.

Turn **Right** onto **Cornish Field Road**, continue 0.3 miles into camp.

Do not believe computer maps that say Cornish Field Rd connects to Halfway Pond Rd. Also, it is better to approach Cornish Field Rd from the South. West Long Pond Rd, North of Cornish Field is dirt, windy and close to neighbors.

The last part of the route is narrow, rutted, winding, bumpy and hidden from the world.

If you have not been to Pinewoods, plan to arrive before dark.
